1. School Food

Hope Valley College is proud to offer freshly made food, cooked on-site by our in-house catering team in our dedicated dining room.

We recognise that a great school food culture improves pupil health & wellbeing. As part of this we aim to:

- Offer tasty, nutritionally balanced meals, that cater for a wide range of dietary requirements.
- Use local businesses where possible to supply our products.
- All of our sandwich packaging is biodegradable.
- We are in the process of phasing out all single use plastics and all of our drink's cartons and cans and other packaging is recycled.
- All of our food that is prepared and pre-packed for sale is fully compliant with allergen labelling law that came into effect from 1 October 2021

2. Free School Meals – How it Works.

The school operates a cashless catering system, and a £3.00 allowance is automatically credited to your child's account each day to purchase food. This amount is sufficient to buy a "meal deal" at lunchtime. If your child wishes to purchase anything above the allowance, including food at break or additional drinks, extra funds can be added using the online payment software called Parent Pay.

If the full meal allowance is not used up daily, any surplus will be lost - it will not roll over to the next day.
